### **Court Appointed Attorney Information**

#### **How do I get a Court Appointed Attorney?**

If the City Attorney's office is requesting additional jail time and you cannot afford an attorney, the Court will appoint an attorney for you. In some cases, when a person has adequate income, attorney fees in the amount no more than \$250 will be assessed. These fees must be paid by the defendant. To apply for a Court Appointed Attorney you must complete a Financial Affidavit and submitted it to the Court, along with supporting documentation. This paperwork may be obtained online under the forms section or at the information booth located in the Municipal Court lobby. After review, the Affidavit will be approved or denied and the Court will notify the defendant regarding the appointment.
