Items pictured above are the only items that should go into your **BLUE** lid cart. All other items not pictured above go into the **BLACK** lid cart. Please keep this page easily accessible for your reference.

“Do not overfill your cart. Lid should close fully.”



The “Clean Community and Enhanced Recycling Program” uses new automated trucks. The driver will not be able to load your trash without the new supplied carts. As you can see, you no longer need to bag nor separate your recyclables.



Place your carts at the curb the night before your scheduled collection day. If you find yourself with additional bags that do not fit in your containers, put them next to the cart and the driver will reload the cart one more time.



Palm fronds and other house hold appliances are considered bulk items and will only be collected on your scheduled bulk pick up days. Palm fronds must be tied up. See your schedule for dates or visit www.republicservicesvegas.com and click on Home then Pilot and then Bulky Items.

CONGRATULATIONS!!

Your neighborhood has been selected to participate in the “Clean Community and Enhanced Recycling Program”. In this program, Republic Services will provide a 96-gallon, wheeled cart for trash and a 96-gallon, wheeled cart for recycling at no charge.

This means:

- You will no longer need to separate and sort your recyclables using the red, white and blue bins. Instead you will use one cart for ALL your recyclables. This is called commingled or “mixed” recycling.
- Republic Services will provide a second trash cart at no extra charge if you determine you need it.
- The appearance of your neighborhood will improve since trash/recyclables will be placed in the free carts, and there will no longer be uncovered cans that allow for the wind to blow trash down your street.

By participating, you will join an exclusive group of residents who are taking advantage of this simple yet beneficial program. Also, you will be instrumental in helping Republic Services design an enhanced recycling program for the entire City through your feedback.

Why are we implementing this program?

We believe this program will help improve the appearance of your neighborhood on trash collection day, and promote neighborhood recycling. With this new system, trash and recyclables won't blow throughout the neighborhood on windy days, and unsightly bags at the curb will not be an issue.

Your New Carts

A new recyclables cart will be delivered to your home. This is a black cart with a **BLUE** lid. There is no need to separate your recyclables into separate bins; they can all go right into the cart. We will also deliver a new trash cart to your home. This cart will be black with a **BLACK** lid. You should bag your trash before putting it into your new trash cart. The trash and recycling carts will be provided FREE of charge by Republic Services while you are in the pilot program.

What other changes will we see?

Trash and recycling will be picked up once per week on the same day. These carts are 96-gallons in capacity, and hold approximately three large yard bags or six average-sized kitchen bags. Please note, if you need an additional trash or recycling cart, a second cart will be provided at no extra charge by Republic Services.

Odor Issues

- You should always bag your food trash before you put it in the trash cart. One suggestion a customer made was to keep the plastic bags from your shopping trips and use those bags to double bag food waste.
- Another customer reported to us that they glued a deodorant bar to the inside of the lid of their trash cart and that it was very effective in eliminating odors.
- You should wash out the cart occasionally (Monthly/Quarterly) and this will also help eliminate any odors.

A few things to remember

- Remember, you will no longer need your own trash bins for trash collection.
- All items should be bagged prior to being put into your trash cart.
- Place all bagged trash in the cart with the **BLACK** lid and close the lid.
- Recyclables will be placed together in the cart with the **BLUE** lid. There is no need to bag your recyclables.
- Remember not to overfill your cart. Lid should close fully.
- Put your address on your carts using white adhesive tape.
- Place your carts at the curb the night before your scheduled collection day.
- Roll your carts into the street and place them against the curb with the handles facing your home. Place carts at least two feet apart from each other and away from objects like mailboxes, electric boxes, etc. to avoid damage.

- While you are part of this recycling pilot program, your old trash cans cannot be used by Republic Services. You can keep them for other purposes, or you can call 702-735-5151 to schedule a day for pick up at which time we will recycle them for you.
- Our new system will be using automated trucks and will only work with the carts that we have provided for you at no cost.
- Remember the trash, recycling and bulky items are emptied by different trucks at different times during the day. Each truck only goes through the neighborhood once.
- If you find that the supplied 96-gallon containers are too large for your needs please call us at 702-735-5151 to receive a smaller size cart that will better meet your needs.
- For the occasional times that you find yourself with more trash than you have room for in the supplied containers, put the bags next to the cart and the driver will reload the cart one more time. If you find yourself with extra bags on a regular basis please call us at 702-735-5151 to receive a larger size cart that will better meet your needs.
- Items that are too large for the cart, such as furniture, appliances, or yard waste will continue to be collected on scheduled bulk pick up days. See your schedule for dates or visit www.republicservicesvegas.com
- Republic Services is happy to repair any broken trash or recycling carts or replace a stolen cart free of charge. Just call 702-735-5151 to schedule an appointment.
- When moving, consider each set of carts part of the residence. Simply leave them at the home when you move. If you are moving within the pilot program area, new carts will be delivered to you.
- Recycle bins will be picked up on your last scheduled recycle basket day. See your schedule for dates.
